



## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is a typical day like at a camp?

A typical day at the camp begins with a wholesome breakfast, students then partake in fun filled activities planned for that day (please see sample schedule for reference below). The morning sessions typically include exciting training sessions with our esteemed coaches, following which students break for a nutritious lunch. The afternoon sessions include loads of action-packed programs from friendly matches to leisure events depending on the program for the respective day where students will also be served snacks during the program, culminating with dinner!

### Who is organizing the camp? How are the training groups organized? (By age, by level, or both)

This camp is managed and organized by Gold Standard Sports Management (GSSM) in collaboration with Ryan International Group of Institutions. The training groups will be age specific under 14 and under 16.

### How are roommates chosen?

Roommates will be chosen by GSSM.

**What's accommodation like at the camp?**

Students will reside in a comfortable hotel situated near the training facilities. Accommodation details will be provided to the parents at the time of enrolment.

**What level of English is required to participate in a sports camp that includes language classes?**

There is no language class in this camp.

**Does my child need to have a specific level of skill to participate in a sports camp?**

Skills could vary from being a beginner to an advanced player.

**What's included in the price?**

- Accommodation for 7 nights with daily 3 meals and an evening snack
- Football Training Sessions
- Friendly Matches Against Local Teams
- City Centre Tour of Madrid
- Real Madrid and Atletico Madrid Stadium Tour
- Airfare
- Visa
- Insurance

**What's not included in the price?**

Any other item not mentioned above in the program features section

**When is the last date for enrolment for the Camp?**

The last date of registration for the camp is 15<sup>th</sup> December'19

**Who will manage the visa application process and flights ticketing?**

A designated travel consultant will manage the visa process and flight bookings.

**What is the deadline for completion of visa formalities?**

The documents for visa process will need to be submitted to the travel consultant by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019, all the details for which will be shared by the travel consultant.

**What are the details of the flights that need to be booked ?**

The flight details and itinerary will be shared by the travel consultant.

**What is the cost of the flights, can we book through a travel consultant and who will the cost be borne by?**

The cost of the flights is incorporated in the program fee and bookings will be done by the travel consultant.

**Where will the flight to Madrid depart from?**

The flight to Madrid will depart from Mumbai.

**Will I have to pay for anything once my child is already at the camp?**

Unless a student wants anything other than what the camp provides there is no additional cost that needs to be borne.

**Once my child is at camp, is it possible to extend their stay?**

Once the camp is completed students can travel with parents from Madrid after completing formalities that will be prescribed on request.

**Once my child is at camp, can he/she visit some of our family friends?**

No, meeting with anybody other than the official staff during the camp is prohibited.

**How can I contact my child during their stay at camp?**

Students can carry their cell phones and they can buy a local sim at their own cost or take international roaming as deemed best by the parent. Contact details of the teacher who will be travelling will also be provided to the parents.

**What are the camp rules?**

All terms and conditions will be mentioned in the enrolment forms which will be provided.

**How are campers supervised during the different activities on and off the camp's campus?**

The students will be under the supervision of school teacher, GSSM staff and coaches

**How many hours of training per week does the program include?**

The camp consists of 7 training sessions of minimum an hour each in addition to 3 matches against local teams.

**Who are the trainers?**

The students will be trained by UEFA Licensed Coaches during the program

**What is the total number of participants, and what's their skill level? Do participants train in large, medium, or small groups, and do participants train with other players of the same level?**

16 Students in a batch and their skills could vary from being a beginner to an advanced player.

**How is the quality of the facilities in which the young athletes train?**

Students will train on some of the finest football training facilities in Madrid.

**Does the camp employ new training technology?**

A wide range of fun activities related to football will be provided to the students, many of them never seen before with 2 factors in common fun and values as a vehicle for learning.

**Does the program include theory sessions where the participants discuss tactics and strategy?**

There will be discussion on tactics and strategy especially during the friendly matches

**What will the students have to wear during the training sessions and friendly matches?**

The students must carry sufficient tee shirts/jerseys, shorts, socks/stockings for the training sessions. It is compulsory to wear shin guards during all sessions.

**What is the mode of payment?**

Payments can be made by cheque & details for the same will be provided to the parents during the time of enrolments.

**Does the program include tournaments, friendly matches, etc.?**

Yes, participants will be playing friendly matches with the Local Football Teams.
